1 RULES

1.1

The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the [Racing Rules of Sailing](#), except as changed by the sailing instructions.

1.2

The applying prescriptions of the Nordic Sailing Federation, the Danish Sailing Association, Rules for Nordic Championship and Yngling Class Rules will be incorporated into the sailing instructions.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

According to the Yngling Class rules you can sail the boat 2 or 3 people

4 SCHEDULE OF RACES

4.1

Registration:

All boats: Friday 1 August 10.00 – 19.00 and Saturday 2 August 7.30 – 9.00.
at the regatta office in the club house.

4.2

Sailing:

As many races as possible.

4.3

The first warning signal for the first race on Saturday 2 August 10.00

The first warning signal for the first race on Sunday 3 August 10.00

4.4

On the Sunday no warning signal will be made later than 16.00

5 MEASUREMENT

Each boat must be able to produce a valid class or measurement certificate at any time.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on the Danish Yngling Club web page one week before the regatta and at the regatta office.

7 VENUES

7.1

The regatta harbor will be Dronninggaardsalle 124B 2840 Holte.

7.2

Courses will be sailed on the Lake Furesø.

8 THE COURSE

The courses will be "windward/Leeward courses".

The planned sailing time for the first boat is approx. 60 minutes

9 SCORING

9.1

There is no maximum or minimum number of races scheduled.

9.2

When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

When from five to eight races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

When nine or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst two scores.

10 BERTHING

The boats must be placed on the assigned places. Instructions from club officials or from the harbor master must be followed.

Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta from 09.30 hrs. on the first racing day until the last boat finishes the last race, except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

11 PRIZES

Nordic Championship medals and prizes per each five boat will be awarded soonest possible after racing on the Sunday.

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance. Documentation must be presented when required at any time.
